Pulaski County Sanitation is a County Department under Pulaski County Public Works. The office is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. This office provides services regarding garbage pickup, yard waste and bulk items pickups for residents in the unincorporated area of Pulaski County. Trash collection is currently contracted to Waste Management for a fee of \$26.90 a month. This fee includes weekly garbage pickup, bi-weekly recycling pickup, weekly small yard waste pickup, large yard waste pickup, tire pickups (16 a year) and two bulk item pickups a year. Additional bulk item pickups are available for a charge upon request. Tire, bulk item pickups and large yard waste pickups must be scheduled by calling (501) 210-7500.

Household Waste Collection

Residents in the unincorporated are set up for service by calling the Department at (501) 210-7500. Each home is furnished with a 96-gallon trash cart and 96-gallon recycling cart which the resident will roll to the end of the driveway or street (on private roads) on collection day for service. The automated arm on the waste collection truck will raise and dispense household trash / recycling and return the container to its original location. After collection, each resident is responsible for returning the refuse / recycling container back to its storage place. The trash and recycling cart remain the property of the contractor and will be maintained and replaced at no cost to the resident, except for damage due to their negligence or abuse. Please do not take the container when you move. Contact the department and request the service to be discontinued and the trash / recycling cart will be removed. If the trash / recycling cart is not returned to the contractor a charge of \$75.00 will apply. Please Note: Only household generated trash is allowed in the cart. The following debris is not allowed in the WM trash cart: appliances, electronics, flammables, chemical/radioactive material, paint, construction material, dead animal remains, any type of oil, medical waste, needles and/or bodily semi-solids and bodily fluids.

Small Yard Waste

Your scheduled day for small yard waste will be the day after your regularly scheduled household trash pickup. Yard debris consist of leaves, twigs / sticks or brush that is bagged and at placed at the curb. Please do not co-mingle yard waste and household garbage.

Tree limbs and brush

Large piles of limbs and brush must be scheduled for pick up by calling (501) 210-7500. If you have a tree professionally cut down, the contractor must remove the debris from your property

Bulk Item Pickup

All requests for bulk item pickups must be scheduled by calling (501) 210-7500. Items should be placed in the right-of-way within five (5) feet of the road. Please do not place the items in the road or where they will become a traffic hazard. The following items are accepted for bulk item pickups: appliances, furniture, bagged clothing, lawn furniture and regular household junk. Materials from contracted construction projects will not be accepted.

Tires

Tires are collected separately and must be off the rim. Call the office to schedule: (501) 210-7500.

BILLING

Residents will be billed in one of two ways: either on their water bill monthly, or direct billing by the department quarterly. An additional trash and/or recycling container may be obtained for an extra \$8.00 a month. Please note accounts that are delinquent 90 days by October 15th of each year will be placed on the property's real estate taxes with a 10% penalty.

2022 Holiday Schedule for Pulaski County Residential Garbage Collection

New Year's Day (Observed Monday, January 3) Sanitation and recycling routes will run as normal. The Sanitation office will be closed Monday January 3rd for the holiday.

Dr. Martin L. King (Monday, January 17) – No routes will run on Monday, January 17th but will resume and run one day late Tuesday through Saturday. The Sanitation office will be closed Monday for the holiday.

George Washington's Birthday and Daisy Gaston Bates -President's Day (Monday February 21st Observed) – No routes will run on February 21st but will resume and run one day late Tuesday through Saturday. The Sanitation office will be closed Monday for the holiday.

Memorial Day (Monday, May 30th) No routes will run Monday, but will resume and run one day late, Tuesday through Saturday. Sanitation office will be closed Monday.

Independence Day (Monday, July 4th) – No routes will run on Monday July 4th but will resume and run one day late Tuesday through Saturday. Sanitation office will be closed Monday for the holiday.

Labor Day (Monday, September 5th) – No routes will run on Monday but will resume Tuesday and run one day late through Saturday. The Sanitation office will be closed on the Monday.

Veterans' Day (Friday, November 11th) – No routes will run on Friday. Friday routes will run Saturday. The Sanitation office will be closed for the holiday on Friday.

Thanksgiving Day (Thursday, November 24th) No routes will run on the Thursday. Routes will resume on Friday and run one date late Friday and Saturday. The Sanitation office will be closed Thursday, November 24th and Friday, November 25th.

Christmas Day (Observed December 26th) No routes will run on Monday December 26th (observed) but will resume and run one day late Tuesday through Saturday. The Sanitation office will be closed Friday, December 23th and Monday December 26th.
